1. **Lichtinstallation** | Art and Light Installation | Under S-Bahn bridge
2. **Körnerpark** | Well-tended neo-baroque park with café and art gallery
3. **Thomashöhe** | This more standard Berlin park has enough lawn, trees, and bushes for plenty of picnicking and game-playing | Thomasstraße 27
4. **Little Stage** | A small – hence the name – music venue with international acts and regular events | Jonasstr. 1
5. **Böhmischer Gottesacker** | Bohemian cemetery | Karl-Marx-Platz 10
6. **Fleischerei Blutwurstmanufaktur** | Butchers that sell quality meat and traditional hand-made sausages since 1902 | Karl-Marx-Platz 9-11
7. **Rue Bunte** | A community of artists and musicians works and puts on events and performances in the back courtyard here | Karl-Marx-Strasse 177
8. **Bethlehemskirche** | First built in the fifteenth century, this church was the center of Bohemian life in Rixdorf | Richardplatz 22
9. **Rixdorfer Schmiede** | The old smithy today houses a women's center and art gallery | Richardplatz 28
10. **Gustav Schöne** | Carriage museum | Richardplatz 18
11. **Louis** | Austrian restaurant with Schnitzel specialties | Richardplatz 5
12. **Villa Rixdorf** | Restaurant with Bohemian platters | Richardplatz 6
13. **Comenius-Garten** | Pedagogical, spiritual, and philosophical center, opened 1995 | Richardstraße 35
14. **Kirchgasse 5** | A museum on the Bohemian village and Rixdorf
15. **Marcao Flamenco** | Flamenco dance studio | Kirnhofstr. 7a
16. **Gönül's Art** | Local artist's studio and gallery | Wipperstr. 10
17. **Kunstsalon Posin** | Three renowned Russian brothers make art – their own and copies of old masters' works | Wipperstr. 20
18. **Reinhold Steinle Stadtführungen (Walking Tours)** | Neuköllner leads entertaining and revealing walking tours | Phone 030 – 5321-7401
