1. **Eiscafé** | Pure periphery: ice cream cafe with terrace on the dreary plaza | Henriettenplatz
2. **S-Bahn bridge** | Unique view of the ICC and Funkturm | Kurfürstendamm
3. **"Zwei Beton-Cadillacs in Form der nackten Maja"** | "Two Concrete Cadillacs in the Form of the Naked Maja" – Wolf Vostell's sensation-causing sculpture from 1987 | Rathenauplatz
4. **Halensee** | A beloved Berlin getaway destination since the beginning of the twentieth century
5. **Schaubühne** | The theater, built in 1928 by Erich Mendelsohn, has first-rate contemporary programming | Lehninger Platz
6. **Friedhof Grunewald** | Cemetery surrounded by train tracks | Entrance through Bornstedter Straße
7. **Propeller Island City Lodge** | Inhabitable work of art, awarded by Geo Saison travel magazine in the category "out of competition" | Albrecht-Achilles-Straße 58
8. **Former WOGA complex** | "City in the city" built 1926-31 by Erich Mendelsohn | Kurfürstendamm 153-156 und Cicerostraße
9. **"Zitrone"** | The office high rise at Halensee, built from 1993-96, seems to float above the freeway. It was nicknamed "Lemon" by the construction's opposition | Kronprinzendamm 15
10. **Gedenkstein für Rudi Dutschke** | On April 11, 1968, the prominent leader of the German student movement was shot | Kurfürstendamm 141
11. **Araya Thai Restaurant** | Delicious food, wide vegetarian selection, and a lunch menu | Kurfürstendamm 131
12. **Bar Atelier** | Traditional locale with dance floor – an old West Berlin original. Sundays are "Coffee Chat and More..." with Chef Helga | Katharinenstraße 1
